George Weed was a football and track star at Norwalk High School, who later played local football with the Spring Hill Tigers. George played three years of high school football under Wesley “Mike” Wilson, Ike Kern, and Bob Hunt in the years of 1944 through 1947, and, as an end of the war-time teams, excelled both on offense and defense.

During the same period, George made a name for himself as a discus and javelin thrower with Joe Andrews’ NHS track team, and represented Norwalk at the State Track Meet at Yale Bowl three years in a row.

He joined the Spring Hill Tigers in 1947 as an end, and then played two years with the New Canaan Redskins in the Fairfield County League, after participating in football during his service in the U.S. Army. George coached “T” ball for the seven and eight year olds in Ridgefield and has bowled for most of his lifetime.

Married to the former Lynn Ann Stillings, he is the father of five children.
